I come to the Ruggles building to meet with my therapist.



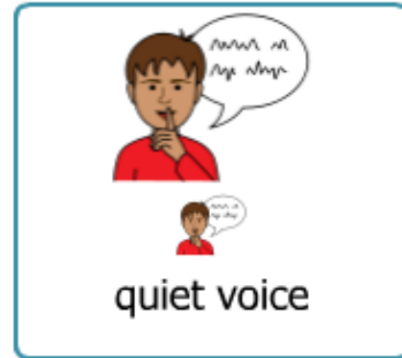
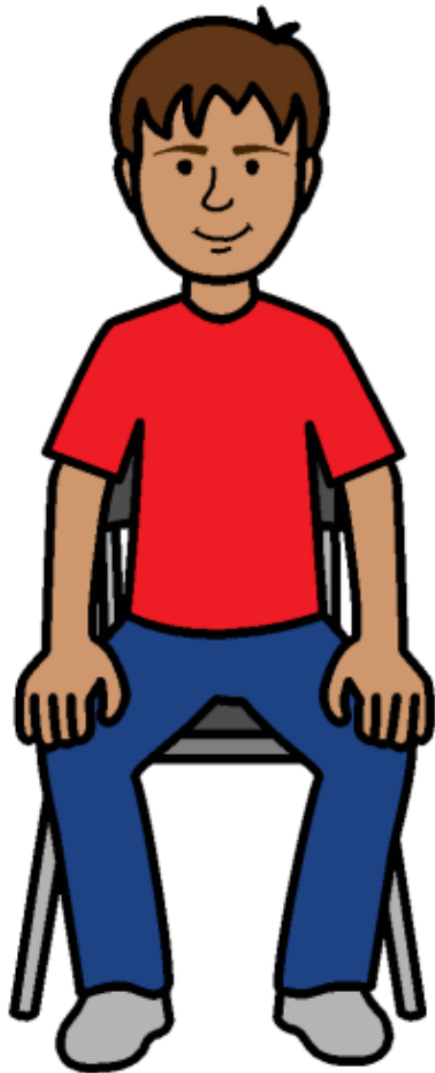
The waiting room is near the front office.



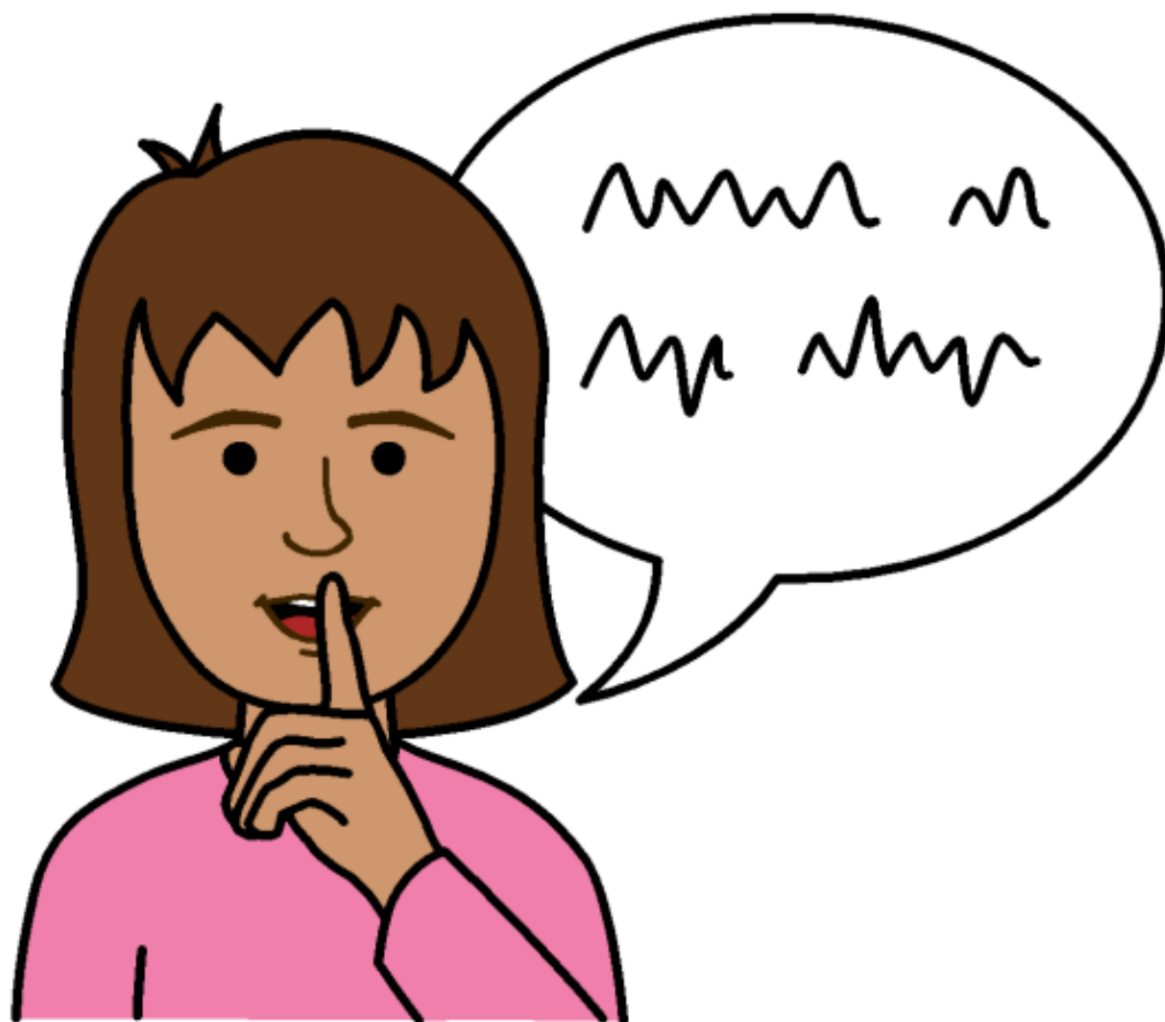


Children and adults wait in this room for their therapist.
